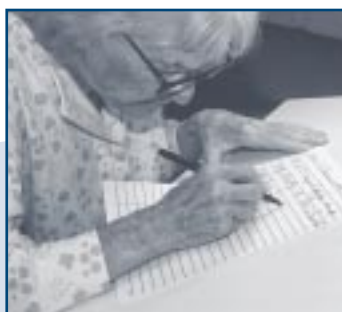
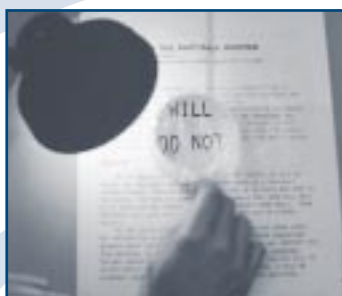

- **Visual Aids Loaners**  
We help club members select the most useful magnifiers (up to 6x) and other adaptive aids for their needs. Use the selection at home for up to 2 weeks. If necessary, return it for another option until you've found the best solution for you.
- **Identification Card**  
People with impaired sight can request special accommodations, such as large print checks or large numbered phones.
- **Access to Our Doctors**  
You may have questions about low vision devices or about what to expect in the months ahead. Our low vision specialists are available to you by phone or e-mail to address your concerns.
- **Sight Support Newsletter**  
A quarterly newsletter provides information about the latest research in eye diseases and treatments as well as the devices and strategies that will help you make the most of your sight.

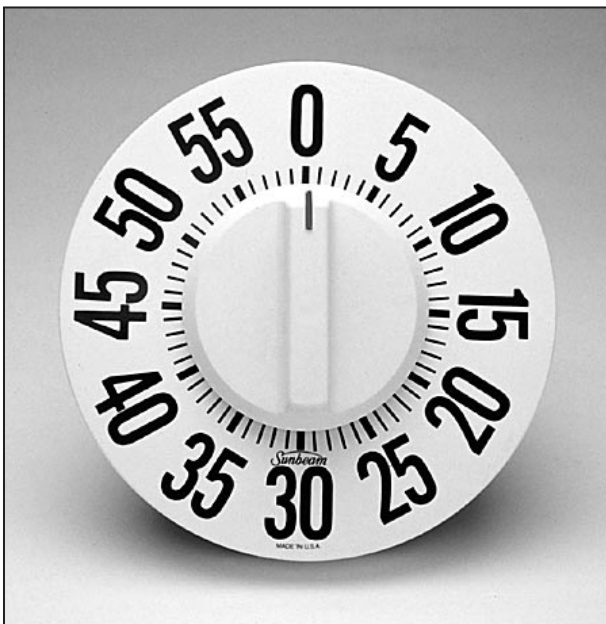

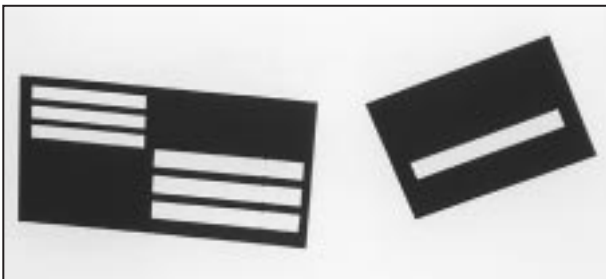

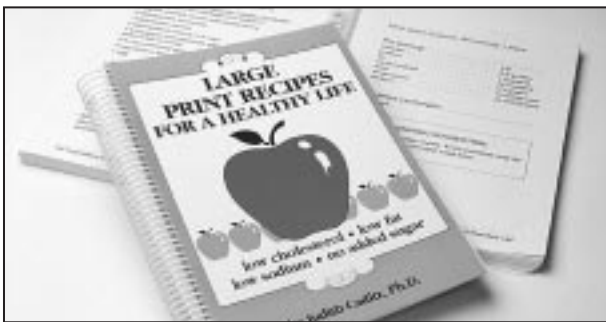

## Magnifiers

The best way to determine which specialized optical aids will help you meet your vision goals is to schedule a low vision evaluation. Doctors who specialize in low vision will design and prescribe devices to help you meet these goals.

The Center store offers a selection of magnification up to 6x for walk-in customers which may be adequate if your vision loss is not severe. We suggest that you bring materials that you want to work with to the store when you are selecting a magnifier. Prices for magnifiers range from \$10 to \$170.

The Center is located 1-1/2 miles west of the San Diego (405) Freeway on Wilshire Boulevard. From the Santa Monica (10) Freeway, go north on Bundy and left on Wilshire. The Center is on the north side of the street in the Wilshire Pacific Plaza building, on the sixth floor directly across from the elevators. There is valet parking in the rear of the building. The building is wheelchair accessible through the rear entrance. Bus travelers will find stops on the north and south sides of Wilshire at both Bundy and Centinela Avenue.
